Scout Association of Hong Kong is a premier uniformed organisation committed to the development of youth for the betterment of society. Scout members should take pride in being a part of such an organisation.

The significance of the Scout Uniform to members is:

- 1. As a reminder of their commitment to the Scout Promise that was made upon joining the Scout Movement.
- 2. To strengthen the sense of identity with and belonging to the Scout Movement.
- 3. To develop discipline and fellowship.
- 4. To display personal identity, rank and achievements.

The Scout Uniform aims to be consistent, neat, aesthetically pleasing, practical and reminiscent of Scout traditions.

The Scout Uniform represents the Association's disciplined image and, at the same time, it embodies the spirit and culture of Scouting. Scout members demonstrate the qualities of self-discipline, self-care, self-confidence and friendliness through their appearance and conduct.
