

3.6. BELTS, FOOTWEAR AND HOSIERY

Overview

1. Scout members should keep belts and footwear clean and well-polished.
2. The belt is buckled up at the centre of the waistband of the shorts, culottes, trousers or skirt.
3. Metal plates are not to be attached to the heels of leather shoes.
4. Knee-high socks are worn with the turn downs just below the knees. The pattern should be straight. Wearing sock tapes can prevent the socks from sliding down.

BELTS

BROWN BELT

1. Worn by Scout members, except Grasshopper Scouts.



OUTDOOR ACTIVITY NYLON BELT

1. May be worn by Scout members, except Grasshopper Scouts, when wearing outdoor activity clothing.



FOOTWEAR

BLACK, PLAIN DESIGN, LACED, LOW TOP LEATHER SHOES

1. Worn by Scout members, except Grasshopper Scouts, when wearing shorts, culottes or trousers.
2. Worn with skirts by female members only when participating in foot drills.
3. Black, plain design, laced and low top.



BLACK, PLAIN DESIGN, NON-LACED, MID HEELS LEATHER SHOES

1. Worn by female members when wearing skirts.
2. Black, plain design, non-laced, mid heels.
3. Heels should not be higher than 5 cm.
4. No sandals or shoes which expose the toes or the heels are to be worn.



HOSIERY

BLACK SOCKS

1. Worn by Scout members, except Grasshopper Scouts and Cub Scouts, when wearing trousers.
2. Black, plain design, long enough to cover ankles.



DARK GREEN KNEE-HIGH SOCKS

1. Worn by Scout members, except Grasshopper Scouts, Sea Scouts, Air Scouts, and Sea/Air Scout Leaders and Instructors, when wearing shorts or culottes.
2. Dark green, with straight pit pattern.



NAVY BLUE KNEE-HIGH SOCKS

1. Worn by Sea Scouts, Air Scouts, and Sea/Air Scout Leaders and Instructors, when wearing shorts or culottes.
2. Navy blue, with straight pit pattern.



SKIN-TONE, NYLON, PLAIN DESIGN STOCKINGS

1. Worn by female members when wearing skirts or Mess Kits.
2. Skin-tone, nylon, plain design.
