

3.8. OPTIONAL ITEMS

Overview

1. Optional Items may be used or worn by Scout members in accordance with their personal needs.
2. Optional Items with plain and simple design are preferred. Trendy items or items with bright colours should not be chosen.
3. A certain number of Optional Items may be obtained from the Scout Shop; others can be purchased from external vendors.

WEARING AND USING OPTIONAL ITEMS

ACTIVITY NAME PLATE

1. Worn at the centre of the left breast pocket flap, above the button, of the Uniform Shirt or the Tunic Topcoat, or in the same position on the Uniform Sweater.

GLASSES

1. If worn, glasses should have frames of plain design and non-bright colour.
2. No sunglasses or glasses with photochromic lenses or “transitions lenses” shall be worn with the following exceptions:
 - when participating in outdoor or sea events;
 - when driving;
 - for health reasons.

WATCHES, WEDDING RINGS, NECKLACES AND OTHER ACCESSORIES

1. Watches, wedding rings and necklaces with plain design may be worn. Necklaces are not to be visible.
2. No other accessories (e.g. ear rings, bracelets or anklets, etc.) shall be worn.

JACKETS / COATS LIKE WIND JACKETS, JACKETS AND OTHERS

1. Dark blue Scout Jackets are available in the Scout Shop.
2. When sourcing jackets/coats from external vendors, those of simple and plain design, and with a dark colour (except the group jackets/coats for special events) are preferred.



CARRYING BAGS LIKE SMALL WAIST BAGS, LADIES' SHOULDER BAGS, DUFFEL BAGS, RUCKSACKS AND OTHERS

1. Black small waist bag may be worn on the belt on the right back side of the uniform trousers/skirts (not applicable to tunic trousers / skirts).
2. When carrying bags are used, choose those of simple and plain design and with a dark colour (except the group carrying bags for special events). Black colour is preferred.
