METHOD OF WEARING RELIGIOUS BADGES AND YOUTH KIRO BADGES

- The respective Sectional Religious 1. Badge or the highest stage of the Youth Kiro Badge is worn 3 cm above the centre of the right breast pocket flap of the Uniform Shirt.
- 2. If either the Religious Badge or the Youth Kiro Badge is worn together with the Sectional Highest Award Insignia (i.e. Golden Bauhinia/Chief Scout's/Dragon Scout Award) and/or the Scout Link Badge/Venture Scout Link Badge, it should be positioned above them.
- If either the Religious Badge or the 3. Youth Kiro Badge is worn together with the Messengers of Peace / Souvenir Badge, they are positioned side by side with the Religious Badge or the Youth Kiro Badge on the left.
- 4. The Religious Badge and the Youth Kiro Badge may not be worn together. Youth Members shall choose one to wear.




ELIGIBILITY FOR WEAR





If the Golden Bauhinia Award is worn together with the Scout Link Badge, they are positioned side by side with the Golden Bauhinia Award on the right.



2. The Scout/Venture Scout Progressive Awards including the Highest Awards are worn at the centre of the right breast pocket of the Uniform Shirt.



3. The Rover Scout Award and the Baden-Powell Award are worn at the centre of the lower part of the left sleeve of the Uniform Shirt.










ELIGIBILITY FOR WEAR
