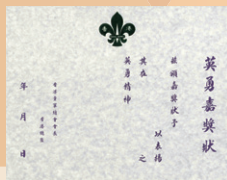


5.3. SCOUT DECORATIONS AND AWARDS

Overview

1. Scout Decorations and Awards are granted to Scout members and in special circumstances to others who have given valuable service to Scouting in Hong Kong, or granted individually or collectively in recognition of acts of gallantry of different degrees.
2. List and order of precedence of Scout Decorations and Awards
 - Awards for Gallantry
 - Awards for Exemplary Service
 - Awards for Merits
 - Medallions for Special Events
 - Medallions for Special Contributions
 - The Chief Commissioner's (CC's) Commendation, the CC's High Commendation, the CC's Thanks Badge
 - The Long Service Decorations
3. Method of wear
 - Awards for Exemplary Service are worn around the neck.
 - The CC's Commendation and High Commendation are worn around the left shoulder below the shoulder strap.
 - The CC's Thanks Badge is worn on the lapel of the jacket of a lounge suit, or worn at the centre of the right breast pocket flap, below Ribbon Bars, of the Uniform.
 - Awards for Gallantry, Awards for Merits, Medallions and the Long Service Medal are worn in order of precedence above the right breast pocket flap of the Uniform, or in the similar position on the jacket of a lounge suit.
4. When the full medal is not worn on the Uniform, it shall be represented by a Ribbon Bar or a cloth emblem in the same colour as the medal ribbon or collar riband. Ribbon Bars and full medals may not be worn together.
5. An "Awards for Gallantry" granted to a Scout Group or Scout unit collectively shall be attached to its flag at the hoist.

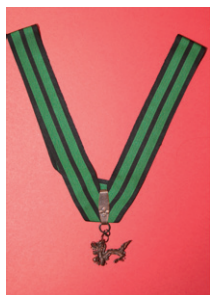

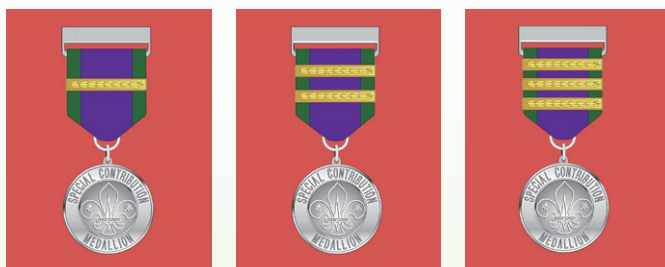
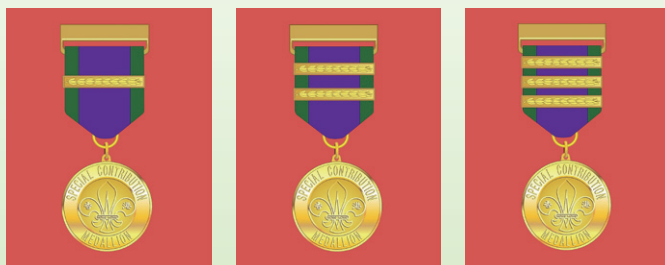
GOLD WITH THREE STARS

1. For donations of HK\$120,000 and above, a Special Contribution Medallion shall be awarded. For a further donation of HK\$120,000 and above after being awarded the Special Contribution Medallion, an additional bar of the Medallion shall be awarded. For donation of HK\$500,000 or above, an Appreciation Plaque shall be awarded to companies or organisations in appreciation of their generous support to the Association.
2. For the 11th donation by a holder of Bars to Special Contribution Medallions, a Special Contribution Star Medallion shall be awarded. For a further donation of HK\$120,000 and above, the holder shall be awarded the Bars to Special Contribution Star Medallion. The 10th Bar to Special Contribution Medallion and the Special Contribution Star Medallion may be worn together.

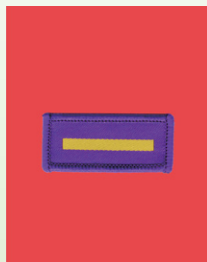


**THE CC'S

1. The CC's Commendation is conferred to Scouters and Commissioners in recognition of their outstanding service in a specific project or task.
2. The CC's High Commendation is conferred to Commissioners with exemplary service after obtaining the CC's Commendation.
3. The CC's Thanks Badge is awarded to Lay Members in recognition of their devoted service.

1. Each of the Service Emblem, up to a maximum of four is granted to Adult Members who have given not less than three years' service.

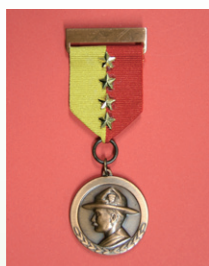

1. The Long Service Medal is granted to Adult Members who have given fifteen years' service. For every further ten years' service, an additional star attached to the ribbon of the Medal shall be awarded.

RIBBON BARS



1. When the full medal of an "Awards for Gallantry", an "Awards for Merits", a Medallion, the Long Service Medal or the collar riband of "Awards for Exemplary Service" is not worn on the Scout Uniform, it shall be represented by a Ribbon Bar in the same colour as the medal ribbon or collar riband.
2. Medals and medallions shall not be worn together with Ribbon Bars.
3. Ribbon Bars shall not be worn on a lounge suit.
