5.7. DECORATIONS AND AWARDS CONFERRED BY HKSAR GOVERNMENT/NON-SCOUT ORGANISATIONS/OTHER NATIONAL SCOUT ORGANISATIONS OF WOSM

Overview

1. Scout members may wear Decorations and Awards conferred by the HKSAR Government or the former sovereignty, non-Scout organisations and other NSOs of the WOSM on the Uniform or lounge suit.

DECORATIONS AND AWARDS CONFERRED BY HKSAR GOVERNMENT AND FORMER SOVEREIGNTY

1. To wear the Decorations and Awards as per list and order of precedence on Page 199-200, Scout members should submit copies of their award certificates to Administration Branch for confirmation and registration in their membership.

DECORATIONS AND AWARDS CONFERRED BY OTHER NSOS OF WOSM

1. For the Decorations and Awards conferred by NSOs or other organisations of the WOSM, Scout members shall submit full documentation of their awards (including copies of award certificates, gazette announcements, notification letters, description of awards and award qualifications) to the Chief Commissioner for approval via Administration Branch.



OTHER DECORATIONS AND AWARDS

1. For the Decorations and Awards conferred by other organisations (including the Girl Guides Association, St. John Ambulance Association, etc.), Scout members shall submit full documentation of their awards (including copies of award certificates, gazette announcements, notification letters, description of awards and award qualifications) to the Chief Commissioner for approval via Administration Branch.

WEARING OF DECORATIONS AND AWARDS CONFERRED BY HKSAR GOVERNMENT

- 1. Worn around the neck or worn in order of precedence from the wearer's right to left:
 - Uniform Shirt or Tunic Topcoat:
 Worn above the centre of the left
 breast pocket flap with the top
 edge of the modal touching the top



- Mess Kit: Miniatures are positioned on the left lapel above the Scout Badge.
- Lounge suit: Worn in the same position on the left lapel.
- Ribbon Bars are worn above the centre of the left breast pocket flap of the Uniform Shirt or Tunic Topcoat.
- 2. If awarded Red Lanyard (conferred to disciplined service officers in conjunction with Chief Executive's Commendation for Government / Public Service) / the Chief Commissioner's Commendation or High Commendation / Scout of the Year Award, the member shall choose one to wear.
- 3. If wearing decorations, awards or ribbon bars of overseas national Scout organisations, they are positioned as per method of wear of Scout Decorations and Awards, and placed after the Scout Decorations, Awards and Ribbon Bars.
- 4. Honours, medals and medallions shall not be worn together with Ribbon Bars.

- 1. Worn as follows:
 - Uniform Shirt or Tunic: Worn on the right of the left breast pocket flap.
 - Mess Kit: Worn on the left lapel below the Scout Badge.
 - Lounge suit: Worn on the left lapel.
- 2. No ribbon bar is provided for this commendation.
