- 1. Uniform No. 3: Worn when attending activities and training events.
 - Uniform No. 4: May be worn when attending ceremonial and formal occasions and conference meetings, etc.
 - Uniform No. 5: Alternative uniform choice for male Adult Members.
 - Uniform No. 6: May be worn by female Adult Members at physically active events.
- 2. Sea/Air Scout Leader Uniform is worn by Group Scout Leaders of Sea/Air Scout Groups, and Leaders and Instructors of Sea/Air Scout sectional units. Sea/Air Scout Commissioners, Leaders and Instructors of the Association Headquarters, Regions and Districts wear normal Adult Uniform.
- 3. If the event organiser does not make any specific uniform arrangements, Adult Members may, depending on their physical constitution or weather conditions, choose to wear a long-sleeved Uniform Shirt or a Uniform Sweater, a jacket or a coat. When wearing the long-sleeved shirt, the shirt sleeves should not be rolled up.
- 4. When wearing Uniforms No. 3 or No. 4, female Adult Members may wear berets.
- 5. When wearing Uniform No. 5, male Adult Members shall not wear long-sleeved shirts.
- 6. When wearing Uniform No. 6, female Adult Members shall wear berets and not the dark green blocked wool felt hat.
- 7. The Basic Badges worn include: World Membership Badge, Hong Kong Emblem, Hong Kong Shoulder Badge/Group Badge, AHQ/Region/District Badges and Adult Shoulder Badges.
- 8. Adult Members may use and wear other compliant Clothing Items, Insignia and Badges and conferred Decorations and Awards.
- 9. Adult Members may also wear BP Scout Hat in ceremonies and outdoor events.
- 10. Before their investiture, Adult Members may wear a complete uniform except the World Membership Badge, headgear, Group/Unit scarf and Adult Shoulder Badges. Buttoning up the shirt's collar is not necessary.
