2.4. OUTDOOR ACTIVITY CLOTHING

Overview

- 1. Scout units may make arrangements for their members to wear activity clothing for outdoor events.
- 2. No Uniform headgear is to be worn by Scout members when wearing outdoor activity clothing. However, they may choose other suitable headwear, such as sunhats or baseball caps, etc. if needed.

GRASSHOPPER SCOUT LEADER ACTIVITY DRESS



 May be worn by Grasshopper Scout Leaders during outdoor events.



- 1. Invested Leaders should wear Group scarves with Activity Dress.
- 2. The Grasshopper Scout Leaders Activity Dress and the orange Grasshopper Scout Activity T-Shirt may be worn if so decided by Grasshopper Scout Leaders.

SCOUT POLO SHIRT

Overview

1. Worn by Scout members when participating in outdoor events in the name of the Association.






Female

- 1. Members from the Association Headquarters and Regions are required to wear the Scout Polo Shirt when they represent the Association in outdoor events that require the wearing of a uniform outdoor dress, including overseas jamborees and Mainland exchange programmes.
- 2. If the event has more than one design of polo shirts, one of them must be this Polo Shirt.
- 3. Districts, Scout Groups and other Scout units are encouraged to use the Polo Shirt as well.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITY DRESS



- 1. May be worn by Adult Members, Venture Scouts and Rover Scouts when participating in outdoor events (e.g. camps and hikes) and may be obtained from the Scout Shop.
- 2. Other types of appropriate dress may be chosen by Scout units.



- 1. The sleeves may be rolled up if needed.
- 2. Types and colours of shoes, hosiery and headwear may be chosen by Scout units.
