4.1. INSIGNIA AND BADGES

Overview

- 1. Insignia and Badges indicate the involvement and achievement of a Scout member and also of the Scout unit they are serving.
- 2. Insignia and Badges shall only be worn by a Scout member who has achieved the required qualifications and has obtained the approval for wearing the same.
- 3. The Insignia and the Badges specified in this chapter shall only be worn on the Uniform Shirt. Those specified in Point 4 may also be worn on the Tunic Topcoat and Uniform Sweater.
- 4. Activity Name Plate, Cloth Name Tag and Mourning Band (if needed) may be worn on the Tunic Topcoat or Uniform Sweater. Venture Scout Epaulettes and Rover Scout Epaulettes may also be worn on Uniform Sweaters by Venture Scouts and Rover Scouts.
- 5. Insignia and Badges are worn neatly and properly on the Uniform Shirt in accordance with their wearing methods. When the long-sleeved Uniform Shirt is worn, they should be worn in the same position as on the short-sleeved shirt.
- 6. Insignia and Badges are to be approved, provided or presented by the Association Headquarters or to be provided by the Scout Shop.
- 7. Unless approval has been obtained from the Chief Commissioner, no Insignia and Badges shall be worn if they have not been approved, provided or presented by the Association Headquarters.
- 8. Insignia and Badges shall not be used on other clothing or objects other than the Scout Uniform, except campfire blankets/robes.
- 9. The wearing eligibilities and methods of the Cub Scout Activity Badges, Scout Proficiency Badges, Venture Scout Achievement Badges and Bars, Sea Activity Badges and Air Activity Badges, etc. are stated in the training schemes of respective Scout Sections.
