1.2. SMART APPEARANCE

Overview

- 1. Scout members, when in uniform, should focus on presenting a smart appearance.
- Scout members should take special care of personal appearance and demeanor to present the Scout qualities of self-discipline, self-care, self-confidence and friendliness when in uniform.
- 3. The smart appearance presented by Scout members helps to improve the image of the Association's governance and discipline and gives the public a good impression.

Manners and Behaviour

- 1. Maintain a cheerful and friendly attitude.
- 2. Be polite, proper and decent in word and conduct.
- 3. Do not smoke.

Uniform

- 1. When Scout units appear in public, all members should wear the same type of Uniform/Dress.
- 2. Uniforms should always be proper and well fitted and should not be mixed with other casual clothes.
- 3. Insignia and Badges should be properly displayed.
- 4. Headgear should be worn only with full uniform.
