

2.5. ADULT UNIFORMS / DRESS FOR DIFFERENT OCCASIONS / EVENTS

Overview

1. Scout units may refer to the chart on the right when deciding on the type of Adult Uniform/Dress for their events.
2. Scout units should minimize the number of types of Uniform/Dress. Scout units should also inform participating members of the relevant arrangements before an event to avoid having many types of Uniform/Dress at such event.
3. If the event organiser does not make any specific uniform arrangements, participating Adult Members may wear the most appropriate Uniform/Dress given the occasion and the nature of the event. Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) is suitable for all occasions and events.

Scout Group Events	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) or No. 4/5/6
Outdoor Events	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) or No. 5/6
	GS Leader Activity Dress/Scout Polo Shirt/Outdoor Activity Dress
Adult Leader Training Courses	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) (No. 6 may be worn by female members at the discretion of Course Leader)
Ceremonies (AGMs, Inaugurations, Weddings, Funerals, etc.)	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) or No. 1/1a/4
Parades	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) or No. 1/1a (No. 6 may be worn by female members on parade ground)
Scout Leaders' Mess Nights	Uniform No. 2 (Mess Kit) (No. 3/4 may be worn by working staff)
Balls	Uniform No. 1/2/3/4
International Events	Uniform No. 3 (Standard Uniform) or No. 1/1a/4/5/6
