

3.1. CLOTHING ITEMS

Overview

1. Clothing Items are used with or worn on the uniform by Scout members. They are for practical, protective, decorative and identification purposes.
2. Distinctive items are used or worn by Scout members, such as the Hat Badges worn by Adult Members in the shape of a plume, the scarves with the functions of keeping warm and sun protection, and the Gilwell Turks Head Woggle, Gilwell Scarf and Wood Badge with historical origins.
3. Certain items indicate the identity and rank of a Scout member.
4. Clothing Items include the following:
 - Basic Badges
 - Headgear, Hat/Cap Badges and Shoulder Badges
 - Scarves, Woggles and Ties
 - Gilwell Turks Head Woggle, Gilwell Scarf and Wood Badge
 - Belts, Footwear and Hosiery
 - Uniform Sweaters
 - Optional Items for individual needs
5. Basic Badges, Shoulder Badges, Wood Badge, Scarves and Woggles are not used or worn with Mess Kit.
6. Standard Clothing Items, except shoes, hosiery and Optional Items, are to be supplied by the Scout Shop.
7. Clothing Items, other than shoes, hosiery and Optional Items, are not to be used with other clothing and objects except campfire blankets/robes.
